

FCFRW 2017 Gun Drawing Rules

1. You must be at least 21 years old and a legal resident of the United States to obtain a ticket. Winners must be at least 21 years old to take possession of the rifle or handgun, and successfully pass applicable background checks, and personally take possession of the firearms.
2. One ticket will be provided per each \$20.00 donation or 6 tickets per each \$100.00 donation to FCFRW. Neither the ticket nor any item can have any cash value.
3. By entering this drawing you are acknowledging that you are not legally prohibited from owning or possessing any of the prizes herein.
4. The last day to obtain tickets is September 28, 2017 or when all tickets are sold out. Drawings of winning tickets will be done October 5, 2017 at the Regular Meeting of the FCFRW. Need not be present to win.
5. Winners may be required to verify that ownership of the guns won is legal in their state, city or town, prior to taking possession of guns won.
6. Winners will be notified, using the name, address, phone number, and e-mail address that the winner has written on the ticket stub. In the event that FCFRW is unable to contact the winner it is the sole responsibility for the winning ticket holder to contact FCFRW to claim their gun. Winning tickets must be verified by FCFRW before winners make contact with East Main Trade Center, 5925 E. Main Street, Farmington, NM.
7. ALL GUNS MUST BE CLAIMED WITHIN IN 30 DAYS AND TRANSFER COMPLETED WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER OCTOBER 5, 2017, THE DAY THE WINNING TICKETS ARE DRAWN. Any guns not claimed will become the property of the FCFRW.
8. GRAND PRIZE: His & Her AR-15 (COLT M-4 Carbine), Soft Gun Case w/Magazines.
9. 2nd PRIZE: ¼ Black Angus Beef (Processed) approximately 105 lbs.
10. 3rd PRIZE: ¼ Black Angus Beef (Processed) approximately 105 lbs.
11. There are no Prize substitutions.
12. By obtaining a raffle ticket you attest that you are a law abiding citizen of good moral character, may legally possess the guns won, have intention of using the guns only in a legal and safe manner, and will or have already obtained instruction on the safe use and operation of the guns won.
13. Winning ticket numbers and prizes won will be posted on the FCFRW website. To protect the winner's identity, the winner's name will not be posted.
14. A limit of 750 tickets will be allocated to this raffle; numbering 0001 to 0750
15. This fundraiser and drawing is void where prohibited.
16. All Federal Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms (B ATF) rules apply. Taking possession of the First Prize is a firearms transfer.
17. All firearm transfers will be done through a Federal Firearms Licensed (FFL) dealer, and all applicable Federal and State laws will apply, including the state laws for the legal residence of winning ticket holders.
18. East Main Trade Center, 5925 E. Main Street, Farmington, NM, a Federal Firearms Licensed (FFL) dealer will be solely responsible for all transfers. All winning ticket holders must make gun transfers through East Main Trade Center, 5925 E. Main Street, Farmington, NM, and in accordance with all applicable laws. Winner pays any and all transfer fees.
19. In the event winners need or wish to have the guns won transferred to their local FFL dealer closer to their residence, shipping and any other additional costs involved with the transfer will be the responsibility of the winner, and arrangements must be made directly between the winner and East Main Trade Center, 5825 E. Main Street, Farmington, NM.
20. Tickets and guns are not transferable and may not be purchased for anyone else or as a gift; the person designated on the ticket must claim the guns.
21. FCFRW makes no warranty, regardless of the prize won; winners will deal directly with manufacturer if a problem arises.
22. FCFRW makes no claims of firearms suitability of purpose of firearms won.
23. FCFRW limits any and all liability to the purchase price of ticket obtained.
24. Purchase of a ticket is not a tax deductible donation.
25. All proceeds go to support the FCFRW.
26. There are no refunds on ticket purchases for any reason, including those where a winner's background check fails to pass.
27. All taxes and expenses related to winning any prize(s), transferring any prize or otherwise related costs are the sole responsibility of the winner. Odds of winning are determined by the amount of tickets sold to eligible persons.
